

Fellowsville Assoc

In 1944 the congregation of the Mt. Israel Methodist Church decided to form an organization for the upkeep of the cemetery at the mountain in memory of their loved ones. They named the organization the Mt. Israel Cemetery Assn. Even though it was war time the hard working officers collected \$540.50 during 1944.

The first officers were the late Earl Harvey, the late Wesley Wolfe, Raymond Shahan of Mt. Israel, all directors; Mrs. Burton Shahan of Mt. Israel, secretary, and George Wolfe of Fellowsville, treasurer.

Earl Harvey, Wesley Wolfe, Clifford Wolfe, George Wolfe, W. A. and J. S. Sidwell all started out the treasury with \$25 each. Various other donors gave from \$20 to \$1 making a total of \$540.50.

George Wolfe of Fellowsville has been treasurer of the Cemetery Association for 26 years. He was 62 years of age when he began as treasurer. Wolfe is now 90 years of age and is next to the oldest man in Fellowsville.

Wolfe had been treasurer of the cemetery association until June 1972, when other officers were elected. He kept the treasury up to date and after all expenses were paid, he turned over \$434.92 to the new treasurer.

Mrs. Burton Shahan of Mt. Israel is the new president; George Wolfe of Fellowsville, vice president; Mrs. Carolyn Bolyard of Laurel Mt., secretary, and Mrs. Imogene Wolfe of Fellowsville, treasurer.
